Report on schools JUNE 2009 TO August 2009

We are very happy to inform you that all our 3 schools have undergone a thorough qualitative change. You also noticed this change during your recent visit to our Howrah school and found the children more cheerful and happier. This joyful atmosphere is now prevalent in all the 3 schools. We have distributed many indoor game items among the children such as puzzles, word making, mechanical toys sets etc. They are also being regularly giving nutritious tiffin. Our teachers have also carried out many extra curricular activities like Raksha Bandhan on 5th August, Independence Day on 15th August etc. On an average there are more then 40 students in every school.

On 25th August, our Executives along with some other members had an extensive meeting with the parents at Howrah. The outcome of the meeting was very positive. The parents look a lively interest in the meeting and the participation was really encouraging. The attitude of the parents regarding the education of their children has also changed completely. They are now very larger to send their children to our schools and send of them even travel a long distance to do so.

Our 3 special support system (Coaching Centers) are also now functioning very successfully and the demand for joining these Coaching Centers are increasing steadily. On an average there are 15 – 20 students in every coaching center.
