Brief Description of the Project

The objects of project are two – fold - I) Education and II) Health

- Education: To create a village environment involving parents and other community members so that all children of school going age are enrolled in primary schools.
- II) <u>Health</u>: To generate awareness among parents and help them adopt improved child care practices and spread health and hygiene education among the school going children with quarterly health check ups for them. One such medical check up has already been made in all the 3 schools. None of the children had any serious disease or disability.

Extra – curricular activities

Extra – curricular activities are as essential to a child as his or her text books. It helps him or her to grow up as a perfect citizen. With this end in view, we organized various such activities in our school. Some of these activities are;

Birthday Celebration: - Our school building at Howrah was donated to us by the late journalist Gour Kishore Ghosh to be used as a social welfare Centre for the underprivileged women and children and was named by him as 'Baper Bari' i.e.

'Paternal House'. On 20th June, 2007 we celebrated the birthday of late Gour Kishore Ghosh in our Howrah school. Snacks and Lozenges were distributed to the children on this occasion.

II) Environment Day Celebration: -

On 20th July, 2007, a tree planting ceremony was held at our Bhangar center. A sapling was planted by our secretary Sm. Surangana Bhadra. The children were told about the importance of environment and the necessity to plant & preserve trees.

III) Independence <u>Day Celebration:</u> -

All the 3(three) school celebrated Independence Day of the 15th August jointly at our Howrah school. The national flag was hoisted with chanting of "Vande Mataram". The children were told about the significance of the Independence Day and they egerly listened to the speakers. A function was also held in which songs were sung. Snacks were distributed among the children, who thoroughly enjoyed the day's celebration.

June 2007

Our teachers started the process of surveying and sensitization of parents of the locality from May, 2007. We received very enthusiastic response and the cases started from June 4, 2007, with forty odd children.

At the very beginning the children were taught to identity their names by writing their names on the blackboard. Then they were shown different types of pictures with difference expressions like smiling, dancing and playing. The

children were taught to identity them and speak out themselves. They were also taught to identity different objects like tables, books, doors, windows and relationship like father, mother sister etc.

July 2007

The children were taught English and Bengali alphabets and how to write them. They were also given primary lessons in Arithmetic. As the children are very small, their have to be taught by telling stories and through games. Stories were also read out to them from books and then they were asked questions from the stories.

August 2007

There was a remarkable all round improvement. The children became quite regular in their attendance and their guardian also showed increasing interest in their studies, thanks to the intensive sensitization work carried out at among them by the teachers. The children have learned to read and write 2 – letter words and are now able to course from 1 to 30. They are also doing simple addition and reading and writing multiplication table up to 1 to 2.

Special support session (coaching class)

The atmosphere and condition of under privileged families are general not congenial to studies. Hence it becomes very difficult for the children of these families to pursue the school lessons at home. Hence we have arranged for special support sessions or coaching classes for them at our Howrah school so that the school going children do not suddenly discontinue their studies and become more attentive to their lessons. At present there are 18 students in the coaching class. These students belong to other school as well as to our own school.



mango, apple, sister, mother, father etc. Some of the children are now able to write down numericals from 1 to 100. _



June 2007

We actually started our surveying and sensitizing job in May and enlisted the names of 30 (thirty) children initially. 10(ten) more students were enrolled in the first week on 4th June, 2007 with 40 (forty) students.

At the very beginning our teacher started with oral rhymes. Then she displayed different objects like locks, pencil, etc. before the children and asked them to identity these objects. The children were taught to identity different colours, and learn alphabets orally as well as numerical numbers. Special attention was given to enable the children to spell out their names and the names of their parents.

<u>July 2007</u>

More oral rhymes were memorized by the children. They were taught to the identity the names of their family relatives in through cards. Some out - knowledge lessons were given to them on birds and beasts, trees, stars etc. Discussions were carried out on our body functioning. English alpha bate and numerical numbers were taught to the children through charts.

August 2007

More words were taught to the children through cards. The children progressed further in learning alphabets, numericals and the names of difference animals and fruits through cards.

In the next step, the children were taught to write on states. At first they were asked to draw lines and circles from which some of them are now able to draw alphabets. They are also being giving drawing and singing lessons and undergoing exercise.

The teachers are also trying to bring about health and hygienic awareness among the children. They are frequently reminded about the habit of brushing their teeth regularly and keeping them selves clean.

Special support session (coaching classes)

Due to the eagerness of the local people, we decided to start coaching classes at this center. Such a coaching center in really necessary at this populated locality. At present there are 10(ten) students attending the coaching classes and the number will increase.
